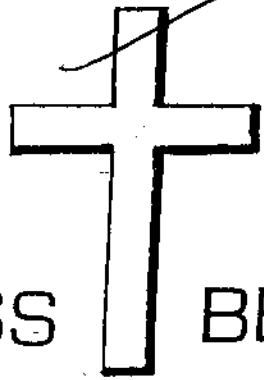

Watchword for June : God proclaimed peace through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all.
(Acts 10:36)

Dear Congregation,

The Apostle Peter said this in one of his proclamations of the Gospel which are written down in the Acts of the Apostles. When we hear the expression "peace" we might be thinking of wars in other countries. We might appreciate that there is peace in South Africa. We have every reason to be thankful to our Heavenly Father that we are able to live more or less peaceful lives. Peter did not think of this aspect of peace in the first place. He referred to the peace that our Lord Jesus Christ has brought by paying for our sins with his death and by this reconciling us with the Heavenly Father. Therefore he wants us, his children, to live in peace and to forgive and reconcile with other people. His peace is peace in our hearts and minds!

We can also be thankful to our Lord Jesus Christ for the blessings in the two congregations St. Crucis and Luther Church. In spite of the congregation not having a Pastor for over a year the attendance of Divine Services has not dropped, and other activities were newly introduced or continued. As initiated by the late Pastor Basil Sonnenberger the Alpha Course was run twice successfully, the second time in co-operation with St. Andrew's. The new building, St. Crucis Lutheran Education Centre, will be completed soon.

I have also very good news for both congregations. You will have a new pastor in July. It is Pastor Muriel Kossmann who will take over on the 1st July, 2001. Most of you have already heard this news and heard her preaching in one of the two services she has conducted at St. Crucis or the one service at Luther Church. I hope that you will be very happy with her. May you grow further in faith and obedience towards the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

I give many thanks to the Church Wardens, group-leaders, organists and lay-readers as well as to the parish secretary Mrs. Charlotte Andrews. By looking after you for over a year, I have benefitted by getting to know new people and new ways. You have helped me very much and the Committee were extremely well organised.

The fellowship between St. Crucis and St. Andrew's has improved a lot especially through the joint Alpha Course and some joint Divine Services. I think that this fellowship will not get lost. We might hold the Alpha II Course together. Details will be discussed among the leaders after Synod. Synod will be held from 1st to 4th June at Bellville/Cape Town.

Let me close this last address in your newsletter as pastor in charge by inviting all of you to the Church Day which will be held on Sunday 26th August at St. Andrew's and by wishing you everything of the best under the love and guidance of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Promising you and your new Pastor my continued support.

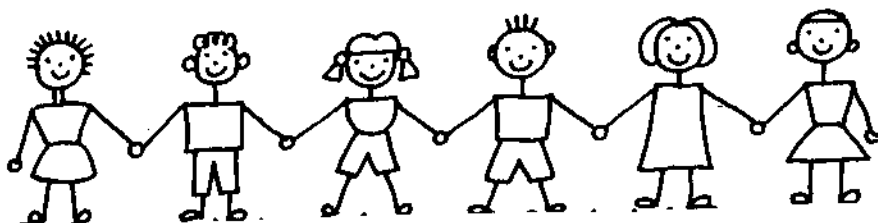
SENIOR YOUTH

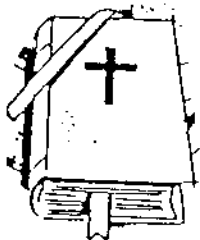
